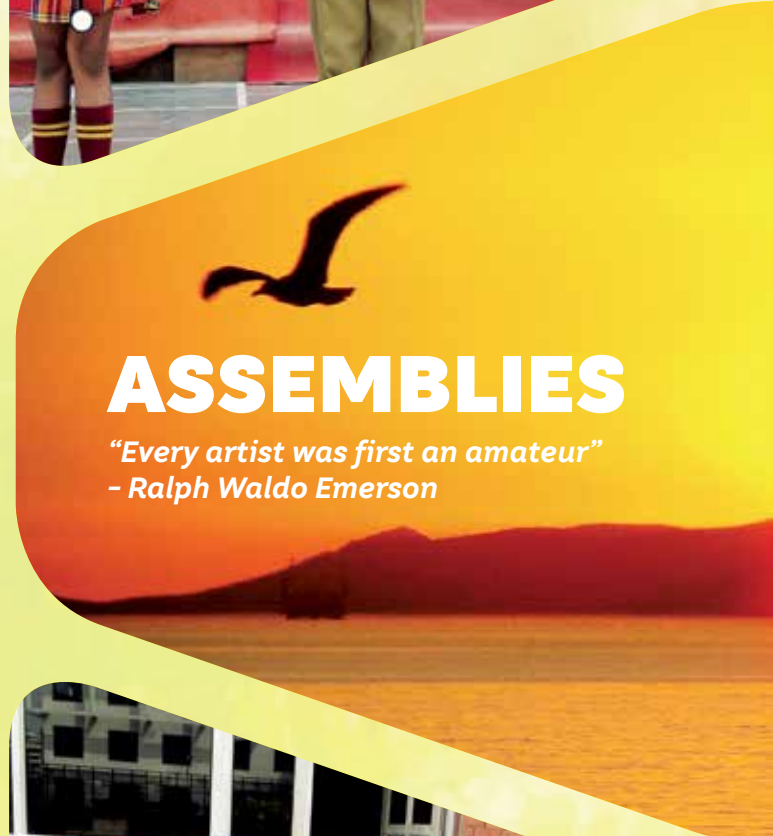
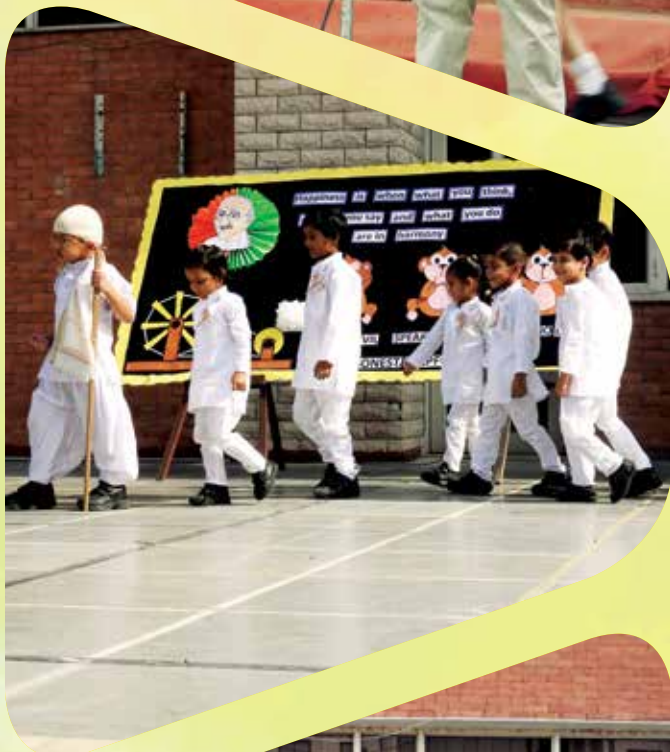
ANNUAL SCHOOL EXHIBITION

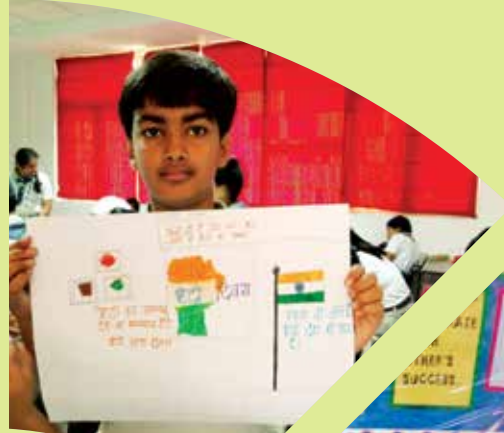

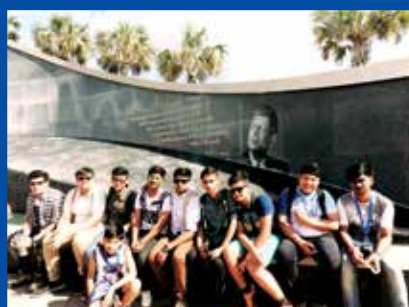


TRIP TO NASA

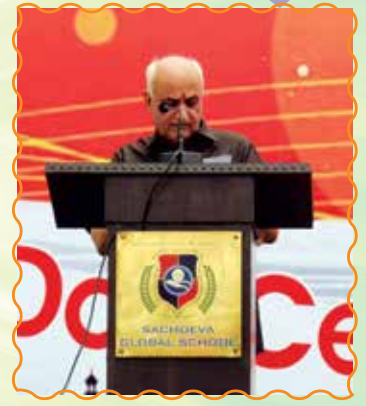

The asteroid must be observed a second time within the next 7-10 days. If it is, then the discovery is changed to provisional status by Minor Planet Center (MPC). Asteroid discoveries with provisional status are maintained in the MPC database for many years, until there have been a sufficient number of observations to fully determine the orbit. That process typically takes 6 years, at which point the asteroid is numbered and catalogued by International Astronomical Union.

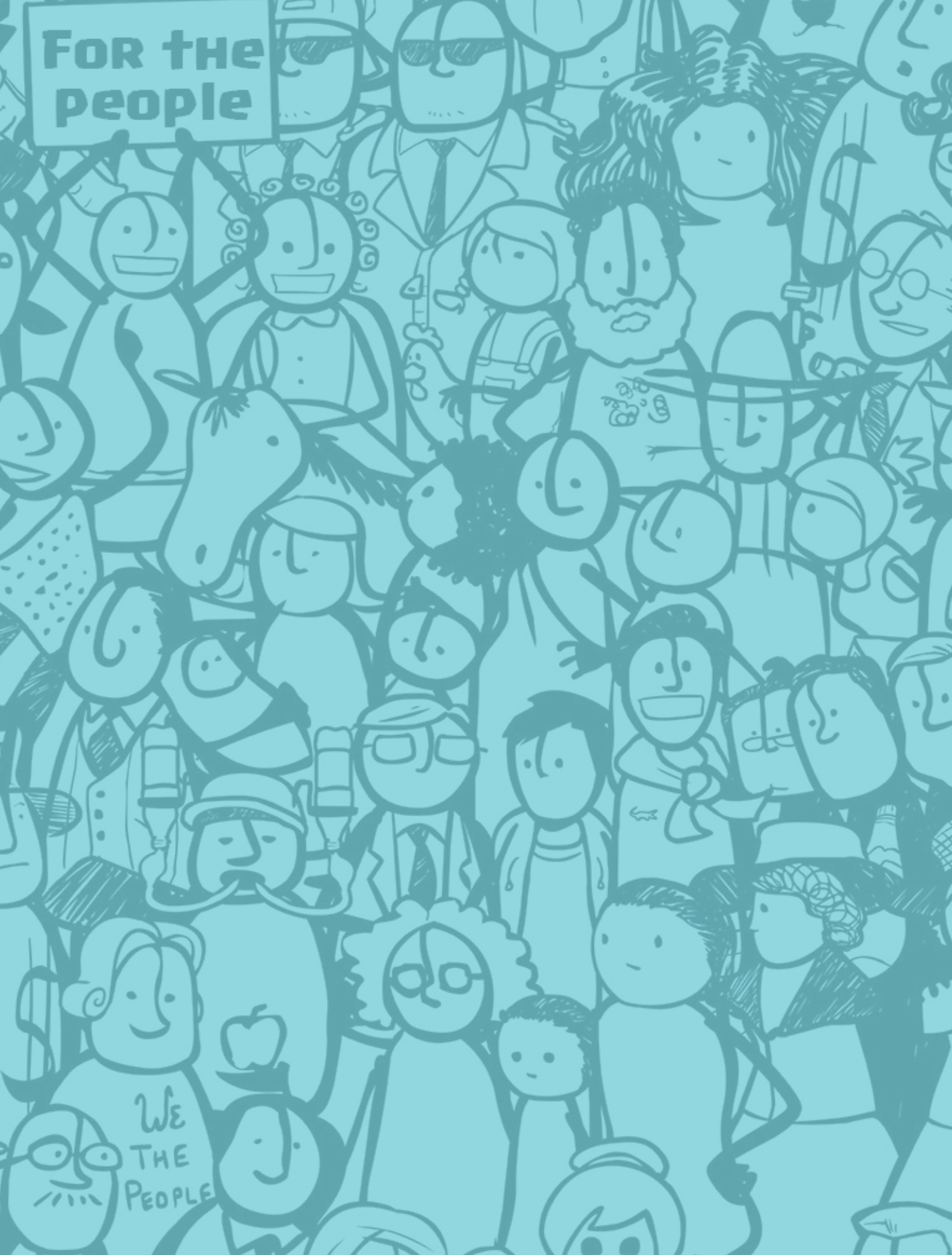

NARENDRER SINGH KAPANY: PHYSICIST

Narinder Singh Kapany was born to a Sikh family in Moga, Punjab, and studied at Agra University. He served briefly as an Indian Ordnance Factories Service officer. While working in an ordnance factory after graduation, Kapany thought that light need not travel in a straight line, that it could be bent. After that he went to Imperial College London in 1952 to work on a Ph.D. degree in optics. In 1960 Dr. Narinder Singh Kapany, wrote an article in Scientific American which coined a new term, called – 'Fiber Optics'. At Imperial College, Kapany worked with Harold Hopkins on transmission through fibers, achieving good image transmission through a large bundle of optical fibers for the first time in 1953. Optical fibers had been tried for image transmission before, but Hopkins and Kapany's technique allowed much better image quality than could previously be achieved. This, combined with the almost-simultaneous development of optical cladding by Dutch scientist Bram van Heel, started the new field of fibre optics. Kapany coined the term 'fibre optics' in an article in Scientific American in 1960, wrote the first book about the new field, and was the new field's most prominent researcher, writer, and spokesperson.

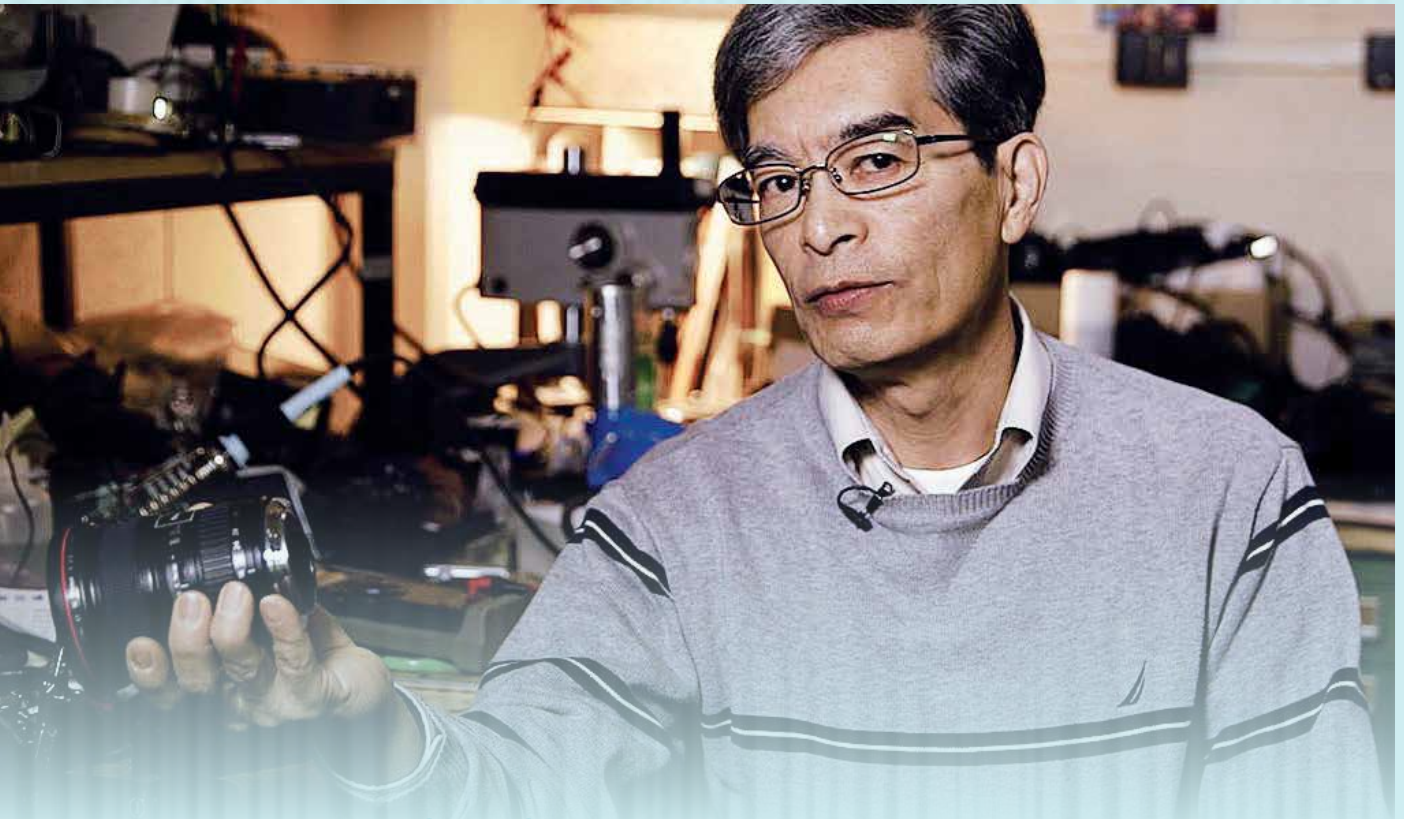

KENJI YAMAGUCHI

The man is Kenji Yamaguchi. A man of wisdom, a man of ethics. Kenji joined National Geographic 35 years ago since then he has helped hundreds of photographers worldwide to "Get the Shot", engineering intricate equipment to capture dazzling pictures.

Kenji had an interest in photography since his days in high school. The man fondly remembers working as a photographer for his school's newspaper. After the days of school, he decided to pursue a career in photography. The persistent efforts lent him a job in the prestigious company, Nikon. During these times Nikon and Nat Geo had a close relationship and due to this, Kenji was sent to National Geographic for training. After spending few years at Nat Geo he was hired by the company as a technician and from there started his ascension and in the coming years he became a photographic engineer and a major contributor in the entire industry.

He has been intrinsic to photographic projects worldwide, working incessantly behind the scenes. In his workshop he has created complex equipment that can't be replicated. Famous photographers and journalists like Steve Winter, Mark Tyson have worked with Kenji and have used the equipment made by him to take breathtaking shots. One such project was with David Doubilet and his team where they wanted to take a photograph encompassing two scenes one underwater and one above water; a double exposure picture. The team used one piece of film to create two different images. Kenji loaded the film and helped capture the images in a single photograph. Yamaguchi has been the man behind some of the most beautiful pictures taken by the National Geographic team, He is an extremely talented man, an unsung hero and definitely a personality deserving recognition.

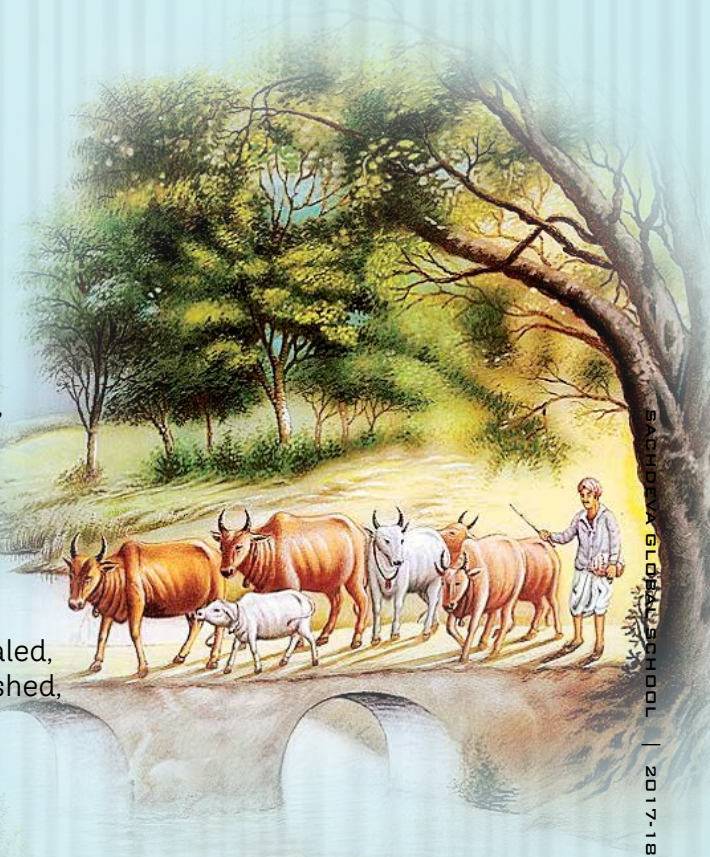

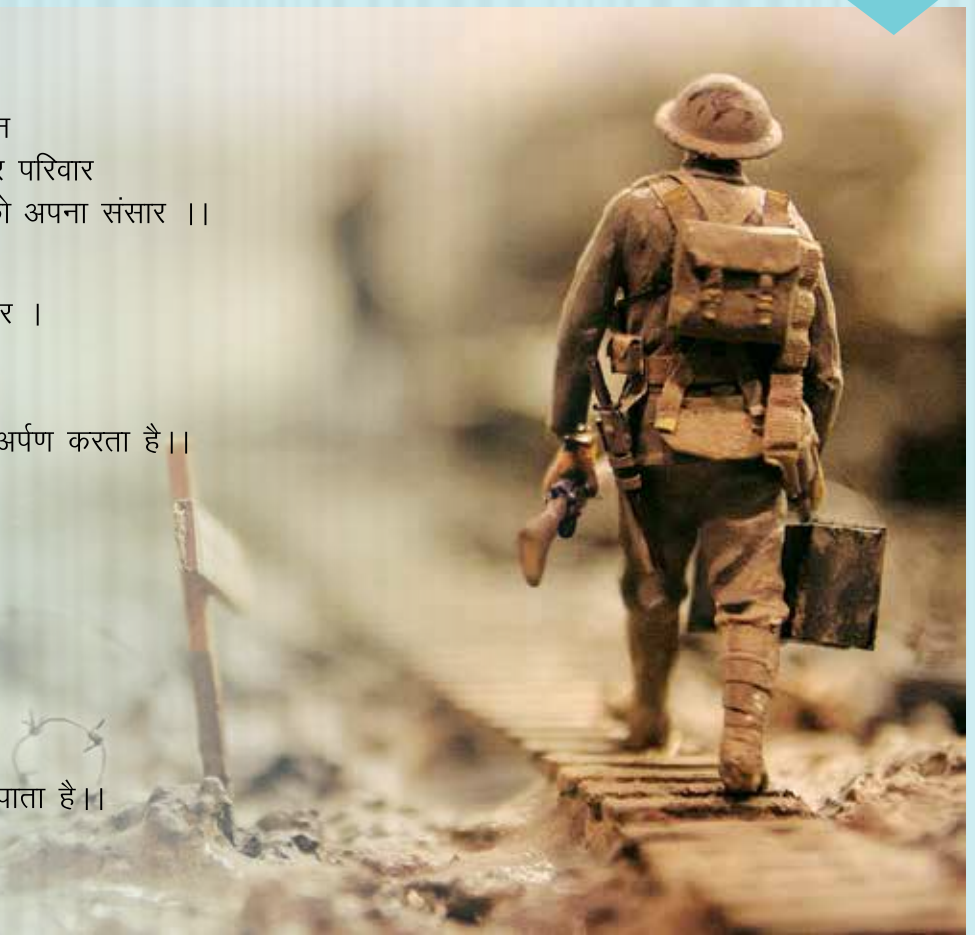

कुछ शख्स ऐसे होते हैं जो महान शख्सियत बन जाते हैं
लेकिन कुछ शख्सियत ऐसी होती हैं जो धूल भरी फाइलों या
पीढ़ियों के अंतराल में कहीं खो जाती हैं। हिंद के जाँबाज
और अदम्य साहस का परिचय देने वाले मेजर सोमनाथ शर्मा
का जन्म 31 जनवरी 1923 को जम्मू में हुआ था। इनके पिता
भी सेना में थे। इनका फौजी जीवन दूसरे विश्व युद्ध 1939-1945 के दौरान शुरू हुआ
और इन्हें मलाया भेज दिया गया। पहले ही दौर में इन्होंने अपने पराक्रम के तेवर दिखा
दिए और इनकी पहचान विशिष्ट सैनिक के रूप में स्थापित हो गई। परंतु कहते हैं ना
'शतेशु जायते शूरः' अर्थात सैकड़ों में एक शूरवीर होता है। उनके अदम्य साहस को देखते
हुए 3 नवंबर 1947 को उन्हें बड़गाम भेज दिया गया जहाँ भारत-पाक युद्ध हो रहा
था। मेजर ने अपनी सेना वहाँ तैनात कर दी तभी वहाँ शत्रु सेना ने उन पर हमला कर
दिया। मेजर सोमनाथ के सभी साथी शहीद हो चुके थे। वे भी घायल हो चुके थे फिर
भी उन्होंने अपनी सूझबूझ का परिचय देते हुए शत्रु सेना को आगे नहीं बढ़ने दिया और
अकेले ही सबका सामना किया। उन्होंने कपड़े की पट्टियों से हवाई जहाज को रास्ता
दिखाया। युद्ध में मोर्दार का निशाना बन जाने के कारण वे शहीद हो गए। मात्र 24 वर्ष
के सोमनाथ शर्मा को मरणोपरांत 'परमवीर चक्र' से सम्मानित किया गया।
