Subject: Dengue Protection



Dear Parent

We at SGS are committed towards, sanitation, public health and environment. In order to join the mass movement to control 'Dengue' in Delhi, the school is being fumigated fortnightly by one the reputed pest control companies over and above maintaining very high standards of cleanliness in and around the campus. To instill the values of personal commitment towards a healthier society, students are also being given awareness sessions for prevention and detection of dengue fever.

Keeping in mind that mosquitoes that spread dengue mostly bite at dusk and dawn, we would request parents to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes in and around your homes by avoiding water logging in coolers, flowerpots, AC trays etc. apart from using mosquito repellent coils and sprays. The dengue mosquito generally bites the lower part of the body, hence we strongly recommend your ward to wear **long socks / leggings (of either skin colour or the colour of the uniform socks)** to keep the lower limbs covered throughout the day.
