Dear Parents,

This is to inform you that the school is organizing a Bag Less Day for the students of **Class I** on **Friday, 14th November 2025**. Bag Less Day is designed to reduce academic stress and shift the focus toward practical, skill-based activities that enhance creativity, collaboration, and critical thinking. The theme for the day is **"Adventure Awaits"**, aimed to ignite curiosity, creativity, and a spirit of exploration among students. This initiative is aligned with our commitment to fostering holistic development and providing an experiential learning environment that extends beyond traditional classroom methods.

Activities scheduled for the day:

1. The Animal Parade: It's a fun walk where you pretend to be your favorite animal!

- Pick an Animal: Think of an animal you love from the following category:

ROLL NO.	CATEGORY
1 to 15	Wild animals
16 to 29	Farm animals
30 onwards	Pet animals

- Wear its Look: Use simple things from home to look a little like your animal. (**No heavy costumes needed- a simple mask or a prop is great!**)
- Practice the Walk: How does your animal move? Does it hop, swim, walk or jump? Practice moving just like it!
- Move and groove: You will walk across the stage in our Animal Parade. When you stop, you will make your animal's sound or pose!

2. Find-The-Next-One Game: Identify the pattern and colour the next picture that continues the pattern.

3. Matra Marathon: A fun and creative way to learn matras so that students can easily connect the vowel sound (स्वर) with its written symbol (मैत्रा) and form new words.

4. Camlin Contest: A fun-filled drawing and colouring competition will be conducted on the **Topic-Fun at School**. (Kindly refer the details shared on Google Classroom)

Please make a note of the following:

- On this day, parents are requested to help their ward choose an animal and send them with one simple/ light-weight accessory or prop to represent their chosen animal.
- Ensure your ward comes in proper school uniform. Students can bring snacks from home (dry food items preferred) and water bottle. Meal takers will get the meals from school as usual.

We seek your kind cooperation in ensuring your ward's participation in making this day a memorable learning experience for our young learners. This initiative will reduce the boundary between textbook knowledge and its practical, real-world application through hands-on activities, projects, and exploration.
