This is to inform you that the school is organizing a Bag Less Day for the students of **Classes I & II** on **Thursday, 25th September 2025**. Bag Less Day will provide students with an opportunity to break free from the confines of their heavy bags and engage in various activities that stimulate their creativity, social skills and creative thinking abilities. The theme for the day is "**Meet Me, My Way**", aimed at celebrating the rich cultural diversity of our country and helping children connect with their roots in a joyful manner. The objective of this activity is to encourage students to develop confidence in self-expression, appreciate cultural diversity, and share about their native place in an interactive manner.

Please make a note of the following:

- **Attire:** On this day, students will be required to come dressed in traditional attire representing their native place/state.
- **Traditional Lunch:** They also need to carry a simple home-cooked meal/lunch that reflects the cuisine of their native place and describe it to their classmates.
- **Show and Tell:** Bring their favourite things (e.g., It may be any book, toy, pencil, geometry/lunch box, dress or even a picture of their family/pet or a holiday they may have had, or any special item from their culture) and share a few lines about it.
- **Calligraphy:** Students have to write their name in their mother tongue and decorate on A-4 size sheet which will be provided by the class teacher.

These activities will provide children with an opportunity to express themselves, appreciate one another's heritage, and learn about India's cultural variety in an engaging way.

We seek your kind cooperation in ensuring your ward's participation in making this day a memorable learning experience for our young learners. This initiative will serve as an enriching experience, enabling students to connect with their cultural roots while enhancing their communication skills.
