

## **Annual Report 2024**

Good Afternoon everyone,

As we reflect on the year gone by, it is with immense pride and deep gratitude that we present the Annual Report for the session 2023-24. This period has been one of transformation, marked by outstanding achievements, unwavering resilience, and a shared commitment to progress. Our students have consistently raised the bar across all facets of school life — from academics to sports to co-curricular activities. Their dedication and drive have not only set new benchmarks of excellence but have also shaped an inspiring culture of hard work, collaboration, and innovation within our community.

At Sachdeva Global School, we believe that every achievement begins with the decision to try, and this year has been a testament to the hard work and determination of our students, the unwavering support of their parents, and the dedicated guidance of our faculty. With every challenge turned into an opportunity, our school has continued to nurture talent and foster a culture of holistic development.

The school achieved 100% result in both AISSCE and AISSE 2023-24 Examinations. We will begin with the remarkable achievements of our students in the AISSCE 2023-24 Examinations. In Class XII, a total of 55 students appeared and Atharv Deshmukh showcased remarkable brilliance with 95.6% in the Science stream. Anushka secured 93.2% in the Commerce stream, while Ishita Ghai secured 93% in the Humanities stream. Rajveer Singh Thakur scored a perfect 100 marks in Biology. 15 students out of 55 secured 90% and above. 43 students earned distinctions in all five subjects, collectively contributing to a total of 204 distinctions.

The students of Class X also demonstrated remarkable academic excellence in the AISSE examinations. A total of 144 candidates appeared and Vaidehi secured the highest percentage at

97.4%. Manasvir Singh Nanda followed closely with 97.2%, and Siya Mathur achieved an impressive 96.8%.

A total of 39 students scored 90% and above, while 95 students earned distinctions in all five subjects, collectively contributing to an impressive total of 569 distinctions.

Prakul Mahajan secured a perfect score in both Mathematics Standard and Sanskrit, while Ariv Sharma and Smita achieved a perfect 100 in Social Science. In French, Daksh Kalra and Siya Mathur demonstrated their linguistic prowess by scoring a perfect 100, and in Artificial Intelligence, Vaidehi and Aashi Srivastava showcased their technical skills by scoring 100 marks. These exceptional results reflect the dedication of the students and the guidance provided by their teachers, reinforcing the school's commitment to academic brilliance.

The year was also marked by the exceptional performance of our students in various sports competitions at the CBSE National and State levels. At the CBSE National School Games, Deekshant Ranga, Reyansh Parti, and Pushker triumphed in the U-14 Boys Rope Skipping category, securing First place in the Double Dutch Freestyle event. In the U-19 Girls category, Satakshi Singh and Kashish Narayan also showcased their talent, securing Third position in the Pair Freestyle event.

In the Delhi State School Games, Vaibhav Sharma achieved Second place in Basketball in the U-14 Boys Category. The Karate competition witnessed stellar victories with Mayanshi Singh Chauhan and Ayan Hasan winning First positions in the U-14 Girls and Boys categories, respectively, while Piyush claimed Second place in the U-19 Boys category. In Net Ball, Ishaan Gahlot led the U-19 Boys team to victory with a First-place finish. Rope Skipping brought further accolades as Reyansh Parti, Pushker, Ritwik, Shivansh Kumar, and Abhishek Singh Gurjar all secured Third place, delivering strong performances in the Double Dutch Freestyle, Double Under Relay, and Double Under events, respectively.

At the CBSE Cluster School Games, the U-19 Girls Badminton team showcased remarkable talent, with Bhumika Koul, Falak, Vrinda Puri, and Niyati Dagar securing Third place. In addition, Krishna won Third position in the Skating 1-Lap Road Race, and Piyush added another feather to the cap with a Third-place finish in Taekwondo.

Ayush and Chirag Gahlot competed in the Netball event at the 68th National School Games as part of the Delhi State team, where they earned Third position. These achievements reflect the hard work and determination of our students.

Adding to the achievements, Astha Ranjan of Class IX successfully cleared the prestigious Mukhyamantri Vigyan Pratibha Pariksha, reflecting the school's commitment to fostering scientific aptitude and academic brilliance.

Yash Dua and Siddharth Kalita from Class XII participated in CBSE Regional Science Exhibition and were selected to represent our school at the National Science Exhibition. Their project, 'Svara' employs computer vision, machine learning, and natural language processing to enable real-time sign language recognition and speech-to-text conversion, powered by a Raspberry Pi.

Two of our Class 7 students, Abhiudit Singh and Achyut Kumar, secured First position in the Inter-School Robotics Competition at DPS Greater Faridabad International School, competing with teams from South Korea, Jordan, and UK. Their project, 'Smart Forest Emancipator', focused on environmental conservation, demonstrating their exceptional innovation and technical skill.

We also take great pride in celebrating the remarkable achievements of our students in a range of zonal competitions:

Garvit Dwivedi of Class XII achieved the First Position in Hindi Essay Writing in the Senior Boys Category, demonstrating his exceptional linguistic skills. Meanwhile, Hardik Bhagtani, also from Class XII, secured the Third Position in English Declamation in the Senior Boys Category.

These accomplishments are a testament to our students' commitment, talent, and hard work in diverse co-scholastic fields.

Adding to its list of accolades, the school has received the InspirED School Excellence Award for Youth Empowerment, recognising its initiatives to develop leadership and foster inclusivity among students. Our school has also secured another accolade and received the prestigious 'GSP Sterling School Award' by the Centre for Science and Environment (CSE) for being rated 'GREEN'. Our school is among the top 4% of schools in India rated 'Green' this year and has maintained this

rating for six consecutive years. This achievement reflects the school's ongoing commitment to environmental sustainability, with efforts focused on Air, Land, Energy, Food, Water, and Waste.

Our students have also showcased exceptional talent and academic excellence across various Olympiads, earning remarkable accolades for their hard work and dedication. Kavish Dhawan of Class II secured the prestigious International Rank 1 and Zonal Rank 1 in the SOF International Mathematics Olympiad (Delhi Zone), earning a Gold Medal, a Gift Certificate, and a Certificate of Outstanding Performance. Supriya Sharma of Class IV earned All India Rank 79 in the Unified International English Olympiad. Divyam Jindal of Class II secured International Rank 24 and Zonal Rank 21 in the SOF International Mathematics Olympiad, both receiving medals, gifts, and certificates for their impressive performances. Saksham Chaurasia of Class III-B achieved Zonal Rank 1 in the SOF National Cyber Olympiad, receiving gifts worth Rs. 5000, a Zonal Gold Medal, a Medal of Distinction, and a Certificate of Zonal Excellence. Additionally, Saksham secured Zonal Rank 7 in the National Science Olympiad, winning gifts worth Rs. 500 and a Certificate of Zonal Excellence. Deekshant Ranga of Class VI-A secured Zonal Rank 9 in the National Science Olympiad, winning gifts worth Rs. 500 and a Certificate of Zonal Excellence.

These outstanding accomplishments reflect the dedication and talent of our students in the academic domain. These are just a few highlights, as many more students have made us proud with their exceptional performances, reflecting their intellectual curiosity and the school's unwavering commitment to nurturing excellence.
