

ENGLISH

Using different pulses, make two letter words 'at', 'an', 'he' and 'we'. Place it on a coloured A- 4 sheet and let it dry. The picture of the sheet should be submitted.

ART AND CRAFT ACTIVITIES

Art is a natural activity to support free play in children. The freedom to manipulate different materials in an organic and unstructured way allows for exploration and experimentation. These artistic endeavours and self-directed explorations are not only fun, but educational as well. Art allows children to practice a wide range of skills that are useful not only for life, but also for learning.

Activity 1 - Pasta Necklace

Material Required:

- Pasta tubes
- Stretch yarn
- Poster colours of your choice
- Brush
- Scissors

Method:

- **Step 1**. Paint the pasta with poster colour. You can add details using a brush like spots and stripes.
- Step 2. Measure the proper length of yarn for your necklace.
- Step 3. Start threading pasta tubes one by one until you have no space to thread more pasta on the yarn. You can cut a longer piece of yarn and thread pasta tubes over and over to make a longer necklace, which you can wrap around your neck a few times. Tie a firm knot at the end.

You are all done! You've just learned how to make a pasta necklace!





Activity 2 - Photo frame

Material Required

- 8 coloured Ice-cream sticks
- 2 colourful buttons
- 2 cut outs of circles cut from a black/brown pastel sheet
- 2 cut outs of circles cut from white pastel sheet
- Sequins
- Passport size photographs of family members
- Glue

Method:

- Step 1. Join 3 ice cream sticks horizontally one after the other.
- Step 2. Paste the black circles over the last ice cream stick.
- Step 3. Paste white circles on the black circles.
- Step 4. Paste a button on each of the white button.
- Step 5. Now paste four ice cream sticks vertically behind the three horizontal ice cream sticks.
- Step 6. Take another ice cream stick and paste on top of the 4 vertical sticks.
- Step 7. Take passport size photographs of your family members and paste them as shown.
- Step 8. Decorate the bus using sequins.

You are ready to board the bus with your family members!
