Describe a special day that you remember well! (use the template attached). You can either take a printout of the template or draw the same on a white A4 size sheet.






ACTIVITY 1 - Making your own Shape Pizza

- **Step 3:** Count and write the number of each shape pasted, show the colour used for the different shapes at the bottom. Template attached for reference.






