

- Keep a bowl of water in the balcony for thirsty birds and animals.




GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:







ENGLISH

FUN WITH THREE LETTER WORDS

Materials required:

- Colourful A4 sheets
- Cloth pegs
- Black marker
- Scissor
- Double sided tape
- Cardboard
- Sketch pens
- Paper cutter



Take any light coloured A4 sheet. Cut it vertically into five equal parts (approximately 6 cm horizontally each). Now paste that sheet on the cardboard for durability. Now divide this strip into eight sections. On top write 'a' sound and write seven different consonants down in each section. Now on any colourful sheet, draw a fish and outline and decorate it nicely. Near the tail end of the fish write the respective family for eg: 'at', 'an', 'ap', 'ag' and 'ad'. as per the instructions mentioned below. Same should be followed for other vowel sounds. Now using a paper cutter make a hole near the mouth of the fish. Paste the fish on the cloth peg using double sided tape. Your word game is ready. Refer to the link of the video shared for reference.

Instructions-

Roll No: 1 to 7 - 'a' sound family (at, an, ap, ad, ag) Roll No: 8 to 14 - 'e' sound family (en, ed, et, eg) Roll No: 15 to 21 - 'i' sound family (in, id, ig, it, ib) Roll No: 22 to 28 - 'o' sound family (ot, ox, op, og, oy) Roll No: 29 to 36 - 'u' sound family (un, ub, ug, ut, up)

Note: Follow school script only.



MATHEMATICS

MY NUMBER MAT

Material Required:

- A4 size pastel sheet of any colour
- Glitter tape
- Black sketch pen
- Thick book
- Real flowers and leaves
- Glue



Go for a nature walk and collect flowers and leaves of different size and shapes. Let it dry by placing them in between the thick book for about 10-12 days. Now take an A-4 size sheet and place all the dried flowers and leaves on it. Lastly count and write the number of flowers and leaves collected at the bottom of the sheet. Laminate the sheet and your table mat is ready!

Note: Mention your name and class at the back of the mat.

GENERAL AWARENESS

BIRD FEEDER

Material Required:

- Waste Plastic bottle
- Thick disposable plate
- Decorative items like sequins
- Poster colour
- Brush
- Glue
- Thick string
- Stick



Remove the cap from the clean plastic bottle. Use a pin (under parent's supervision) to punch a hole at the base of the bottle. Make two holes on the opposite sides of the bottle, near to the base. Use scissors to widen them slightly. Push a stick through the holes of around 5 cm on each side outside the bottle for the perches. Slightly above each perch, use scissors to cut a feeding hole of a coin size. Create a second set of perch using the same method. Thread the string through the holes, hen fill the bottle with bird food and replace the bottle cap. Identify the birds that come to feed.



COMPUTER

MODEL OF A COMPUTER AND IT'S PARTS

Material Required:

- Waste Plastic bottle
- Thick disposable plate
- Decorative items like sequins
- Poster colour
- Brush
- Glue
- Thick string
- Stick



- Waste cardboard can be used to make a monitor.
- > Egg tray can be used to make a keyboard.
- > Disposable cup/empty match box can be used to make a mouse.
- > Shoe box/waste carton can be used to make a CPU.



ART AND CRAFT ACTIVITIES

Art is very important for young children. It gives them a way to let out their feelings and ideas. Children can learn a lot through art. As children draw, paint and make collages, they are learning about the world around them.

Activity 1 – Pen stand with waste bangles

Materials Required:

- Glass Bangles of same size
- Scissors
- Glue
- Card Board
- Colours and brush

Method:

- Collect all the bangles of the same size and paste them with glue till 4 inches one over the other.
- Take a small piece cardboard and cut it with scissors according to the size of bangle in any shape. You can cut it in square or circular shape.
- Color the cardboard with your favorite colours.
- Now stick all the bangles to the cardboard with glue.
- Your creative pen holder is ready to use.
 Tip: Use colorful different types of bangles to enhance the presentation.

You're ready with your pen stand.

Activity 2 - Wall Hanging using matchsticks

Materials Required

- Cardboard
- Matchstick
- Glitter sheet
- Scissor
- Fabric glue
- Decorative items

Method:

- Let's cut the cardboard in circular shape.
- Cover the cardboard with glitter sheet.
- Paste the matchsticks at the corners.
- Decorate the glitter sheet with mirrors & sequins or paste sticker stones.
- Use satin ribbon at the back to hang the wall hanging.

Your wall hanging is ready!
