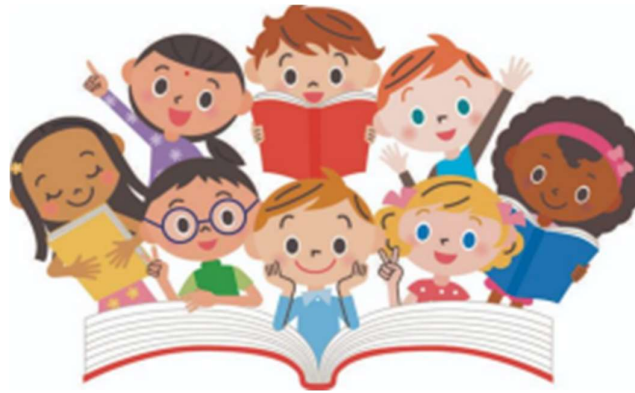

### General Instructions:

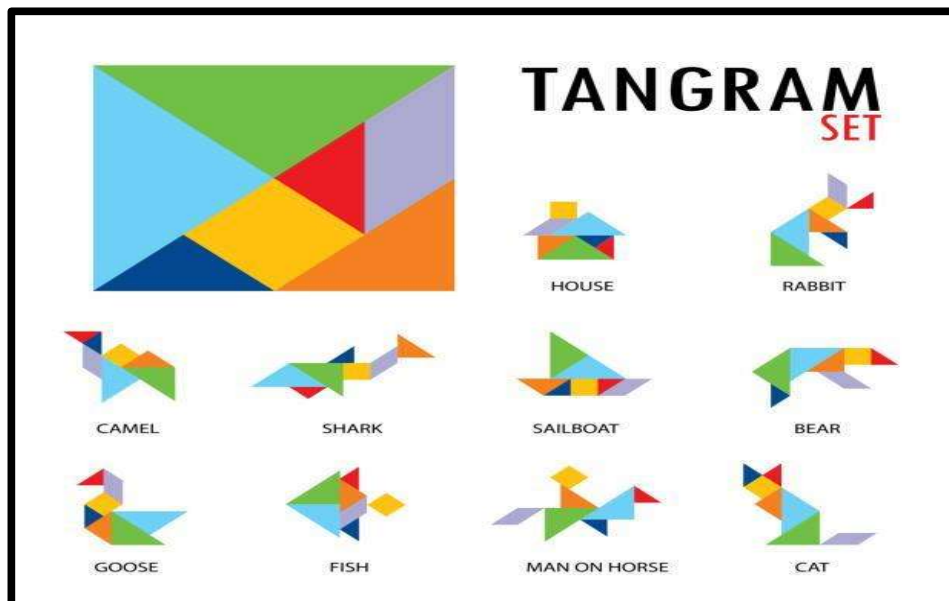
- Work should be done systematically as per the given instructions.
