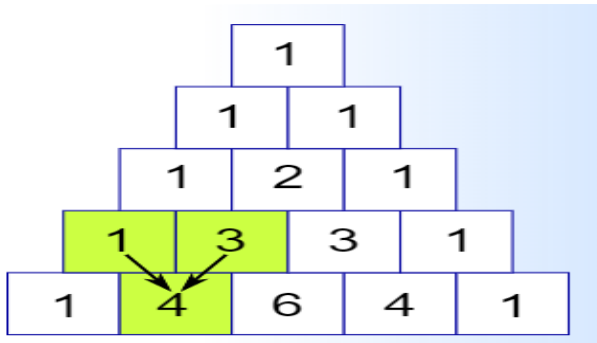
Pascal's Triangle (In 3D)

To build the triangle, start with "1" at the top, then continue placing numbers below it in a triangular pattern.

Each number is the numbers directly above it added together.

For e.g. $1+3 = 4$

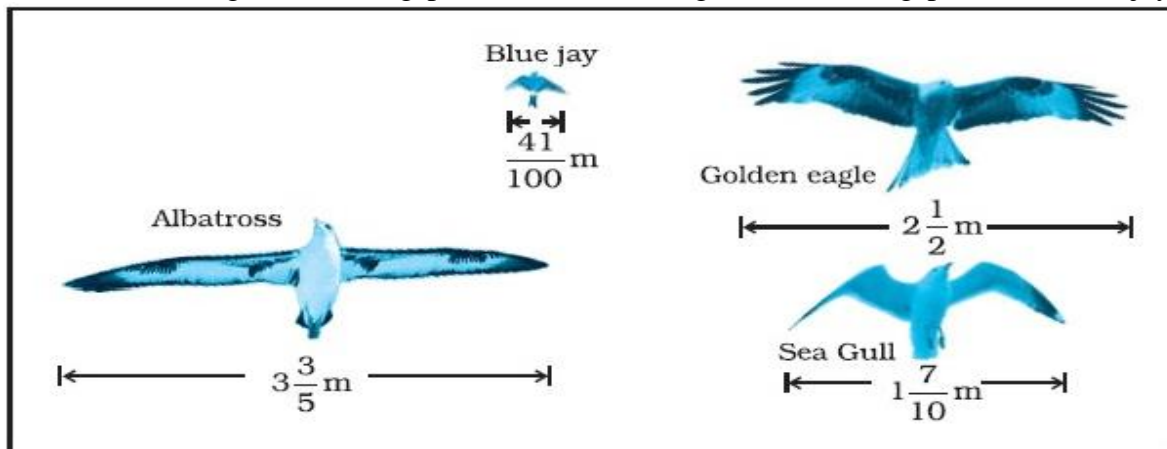

THE TOY STORY

The following projects need to be made by the students as per their roll nos.

Roll Nos 1-9:

1. Make a simple rocket toy.

Procedure: Inflate a balloon and then tape a straw on it. Place the straw on a taut string. Now leave the mouth of the balloon. It will shoot forwards like a rocket. The air will escape from the rear and the balloon will lunge forwards. Explain the phenomenon behind this toy. A YouTube link has been shared for your reference.

2. Make a Cap Tik-Tiki toy.

Make a very nice cricket-like sound with a bottle cap, rubber band, button and some thread. Hold the cap in the left hand and run the right hand thumb and index finger lightly along the entire length of the knotted thread. You will hear a very musical cricket-like sound. 3. Make a straw spray toy.

Cut and bend a straw at right angles. Place one end in water and blow from the other end. A misty spray will come from the other end. Similarly, using a fat straw you can blow out small Styrofoam balls with the Straw sprayer. A You Tube link has been shared for your reference.

Roll Nos 28-38:

4. Make a Squeeze and Spin toy.

You will need a plastic bottle with a nozzle, straws, tape etc. Make a nozzle on the top so that if you squeeze it a stream of air comes out and sways the paper. Make a small hole near on end of a plastic straw. Then take a 10-cm long fat plastic straw and fold it the middle to locate its center. Punch a hole in the center. Then tape and seal both ends of the straw. We have used black tape for its visibility. Trim the extra bits of tape. Then cut a small triangle on the top right hand corner. You will see a small hole. Similarly make a small hole in the bottom left corner. Both these holes will be diametrically opposite. Now insert the plastic straw with the hole in this spinner. Press fit a Styrofoam ball at the end of the straw. Now when you blow from the other end air will come at right angles through the small hole. Place the fat straw right on top of the hole. Then slide a foam







piece in the straw so that it is just behind the spinner. The foam will act like a stopper and prevent the spinner from falling down. The fat straw must spin smoothly on the white straw. On blowing through the other end the spinner will rotate very smoothly. Now mount the spinner vertically by inserting the end of the white straw in the nozzle of the plastic bottle. On squeezing and releasing the bottle the spinner will rotate fast. A You Tube link has been shared for your reference.

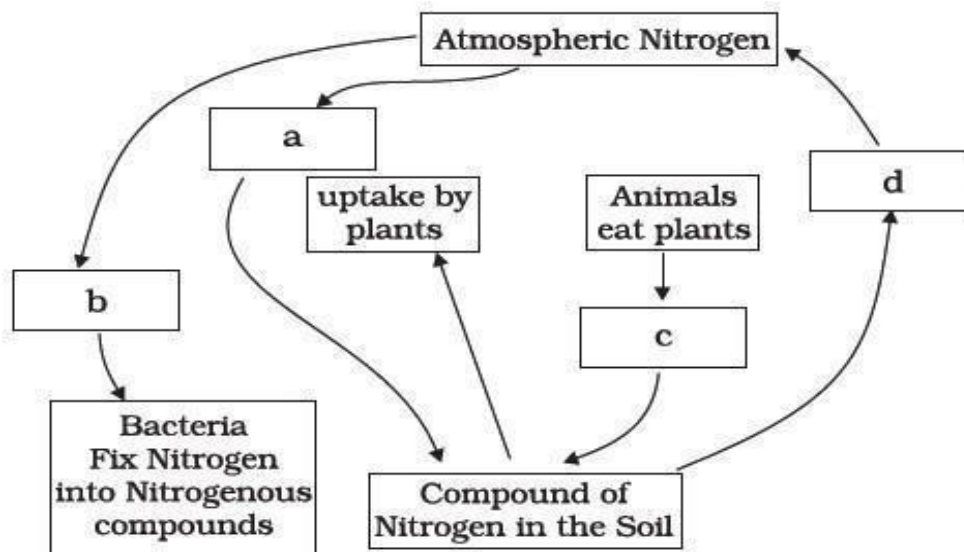

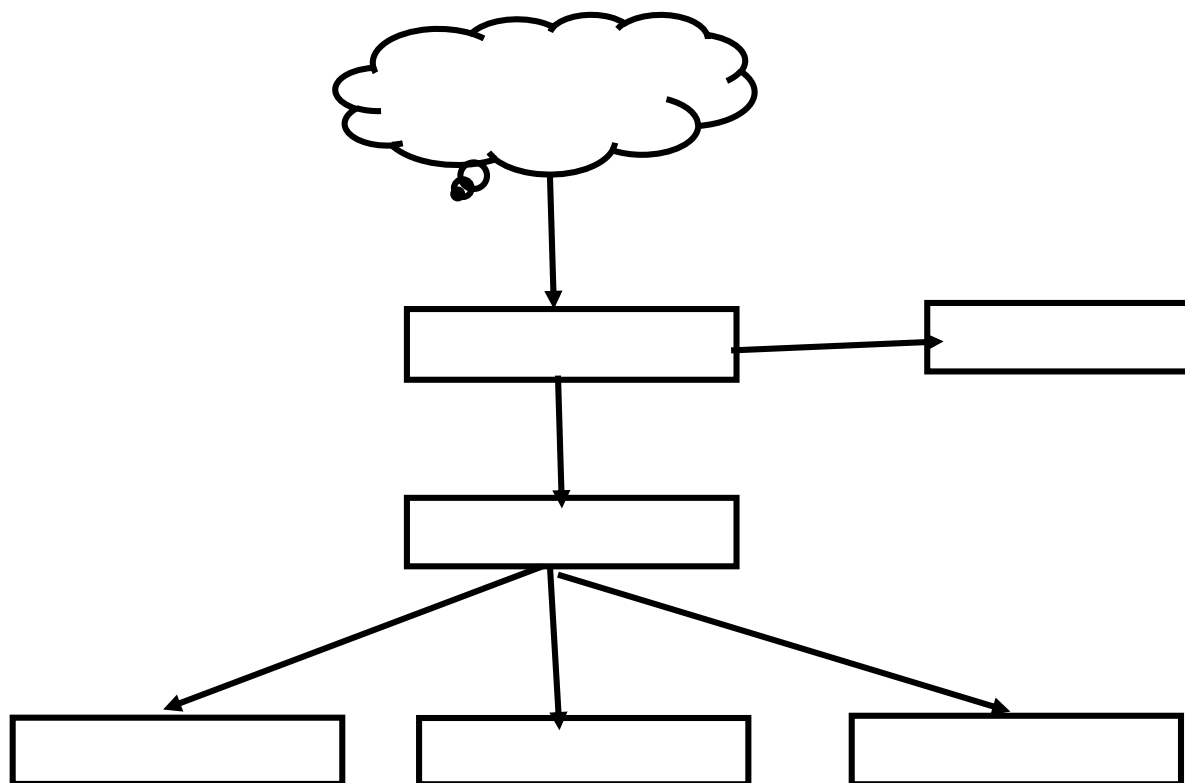
