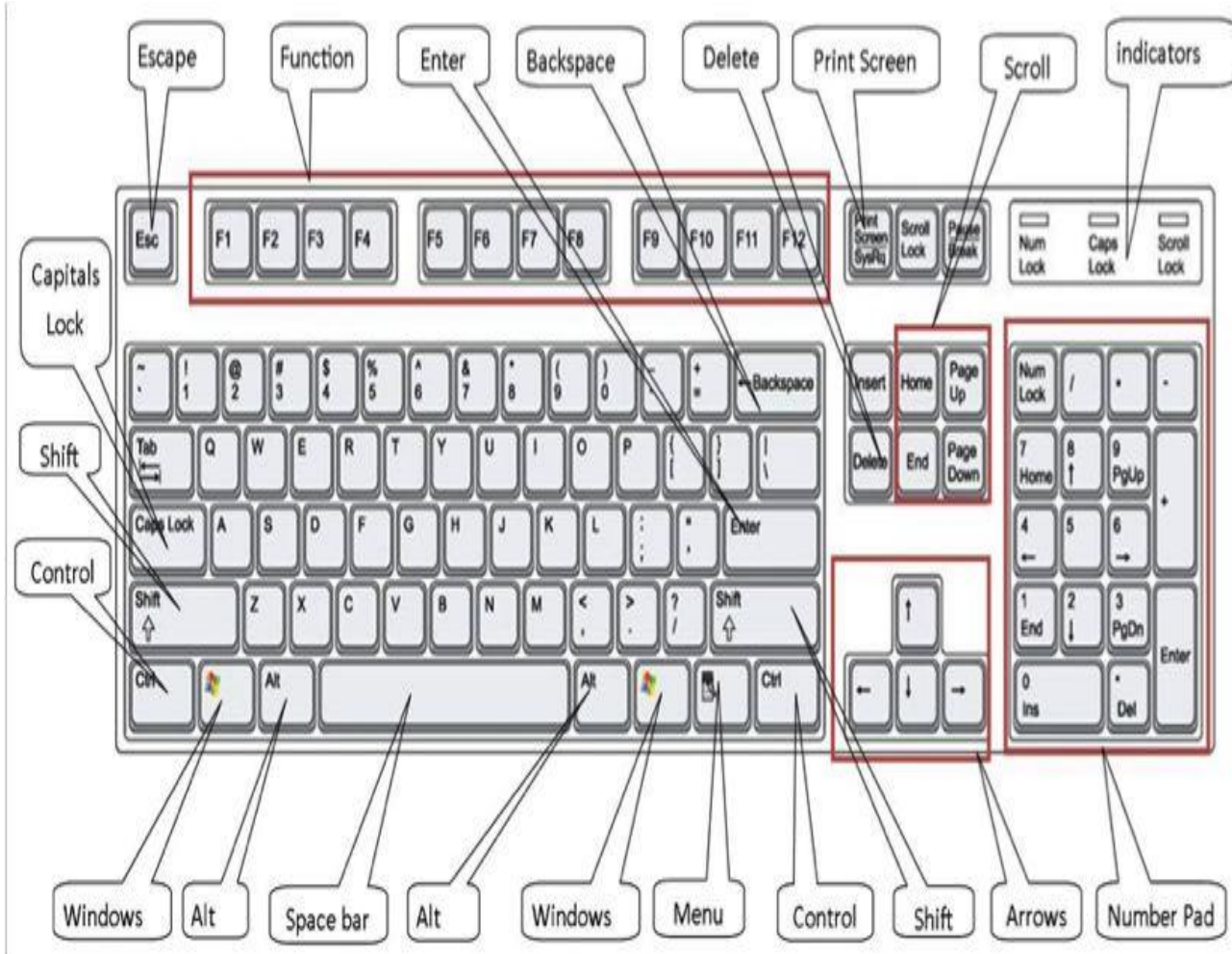


## COMPUTER SCIENCE – LEARNING BY DOING
