An **adverb** is a word which adds to the meaning of a verb.

It tells us **how** a thing is done, **when** it is done, or **where** it is done.

E.g. the old man walked **slowly**. (How)

My uncle is arriving **today**. (When)

The boy is **inside** the room. (Where)

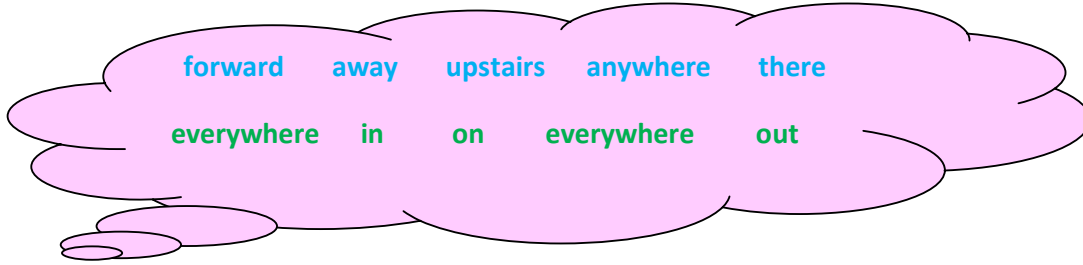
